STATE OF WISCONSIN TOWN OF AZTALAN JEFFERSON COUNTY

The Town Board of the Town of Aztalan, Jefferson County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under State Stats. 349.11, to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Town Board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain Town of Aztalan Highways

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats., effective August 9, 2023, the speed limit on certain Town of Aztalan town highways are reduced or modified as follows: Speed limit reduction from 55 mph to 45 mph on a portion of Harvey Road. Said portion shall include from Mansfield Rd south to State Highway 89.
- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. Stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.*
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highway in violation of the above noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. Stats.

This ordinance is effective upon passage and posting or publication as required under State Stats. 60.80.
