ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS FOR A RECREATIONAL LAND USE LICENSE

The Board of Supervisors of the Town of Aztalan, County of Jefferson, State of Wisconsin, do ordain as follows:

The licensee shall, at its sole cost and expense fully indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Town, its officers, boards, committees, commissions, and employees against any and all claims, suits, actions, liability, and judgments for damanges (including but not limited to expenses for legal fees and disbursements and liabilities assumed by the Town in connection therewith).

A general comprehensive liability insurance policy indemnifying, defending, and saving harmless the Town, its officers, boards, committees, agents, and employees from any and all claims by any person whatsoever on account of injury to or death of a person or persons occasioned by the operations of the licensee under the license granted or alleged to have been so caused or occured with a minimum liability of \$1,000,000 for bodily injury or death of any one or more persons in any one occurrence; said policies are to include personal injury coverage.

The license term shall be one calendar year commencing January 1 and ending December 31.

At its discretion the Town Board may grant a ten year license. The ten year license shall be reviewed in December of every year through out the life of the license. The Town reserves the right to terminate the ten year license at any time during its life for the violation of any portion of the license. Prior to termination of a ten year license, the Town Board shall hold a public hearing to examine all evidence relating to the alleged violation. The license fee shall be set by the Town Board annually. The license fee shall be paid annually within forty five days after the December license review.

The license shall only be granted to an organization, whether incorporated or not, which is the owner or lessee of land or buildings used exclusively for club purposes which is operated solely for a recreational, fraternal, social, patriotic, political, benevolent, or atheletic purpose; but not for pecuniary gain.
