- License applications received after March 31st, 2024 will have a \$25 late fee assessed **per dog**.

The license tag will be mailed to you upon receiving payment AND a valid rabies certificate. It is state law to have the license tag attached to the collar of the licensed animal. If you no longer own the dog/s, a **written** notice from the owner is requested to be sent to the Treasurer for updating records.

Under the Wisconsin animal welfare statutes and local ordinances, every owner allowing a dog to run at large must be fined \$25.00 to \$100.00 for each offense. A dog shall be considered to be running at large when it is off the premises of its owner without being under the immediate control of an individual at all times. The Humane Society of Jefferson (920-674-2048) can be called to pick up loose animals. These regulations apply to everyone and will be enforced.
